



## **'Twelve Days – 1769' Education Programme Summary**

### **Introduction:**

'*Twelve Days - 1769*' focuses on the twelve days that Captain Cook and the crew of the HMB Endeavour spent in Te Whanganui o Hei/Mercury Bay and the events that took place. The exhibit is reflected with twelve objects representing twelve days. The education programme will be delivered in a similar format to our other education programmes.

### **Goals:**

The students will:

- learn about the twelve days spent in Te Whanganui o Hei and the events that took place that helped shaped a community if not the nation
- have the knowledge to identify the twelve objects and the reason behind them.
- develop an understanding of the voyages of Captain Cook.
- be able to identify the members of the scientists on board the HMS Endeavour in 1769 – who they are and what they purpose was on board.

### **Programme Format:**

The session will be delivered over a 90-minute session and will include worksheets and/or hands-on activities.
